

# PASSPORTS

Although not required, we recommend military members purchase their own tourist passport before arriving in Okinawa in case you would like to travel while here. However, all family members must have a valid passport. Check the [State Department Web Site](#) for current costs. The passport service can be completed at the [U.S. Consulate](#) in Naha, Okinawa.

When you receive notification of your assignment to Okinawa, you should report to the base relocations office and obtain a no-fee passport application and photo request for all dependents that will accompany or join you.

Other documents you may want to keep in your possession in addition to a passport include:

- Naturalization paperwork
- Driver's license or permits
- Immunization records
- Deeds and titles to real estate or other property owned
- College transcripts, high school report cards and any other pertinent educational records
- Shipping and storage documents for your property
- Insurance policies
- State and federal income tax returns
- Adoption papers
- Military discharge paperwork
- Financial records
- Marriage certificates
- Divorce decree
