



## Commanding Officer, Marine Aircraft Group 24 Commander's Critical Information Requirements



**My critical information requirements or things that concern me the most are those that pose a threat to our Group in terms of safety or force preservation, can prevent us from accomplishing our mission, or that will reflect badly on the Marine Corps.** Duty officers shall contact the CO or XO immediately to pass CCIR information. Use your best judgment, but some specifics include:

- Death or serious injury of a Marine, Sailor or family member of MAG-24.
- Death or serious injury in a barracks rooms or the on-base house of a member of MAG-24.
- Receipt of a Warning Order to deploy.
- Any change in defense condition, force protection condition, or destructive weather.
- A suicide attempt or ideation or self-inflicted bodily harm by any Marine or Sailor in our MAG.
- Any incident or indication of Hazing by or on a Marine or Sailor in our MAG.
- Any incident or indication of a Sexual Assault by or on a Marine or Sailor in our MAG.
- Any incident or indication of Equal Opportunity violations within our MAG.
- Any loss of sensitive equipment, including Crypto items and COMSEC material.
- Any specific indications or suspicions of drug use or distribution within our MAG.
- A change in assigned mission or alert posture by 1<sup>st</sup> MAW or III MEF.
- Inability to accomplish an assigned mission.
- Any incidents of our Marines or Sailors doing great and heroic things—good news stories.
- A Marine, Sailor or family member within our MAG requiring unscheduled hospitalization.
- Aircraft readiness drops below 50%.
- Any Class A, B or C ground or aviation mishap within our MAG.
- A MAG aircraft is lost contact and more than 30 minutes beyond scheduled land time.
- An aircraft Precautionary Emergency Landing outside of an airfield or normal training areas.
- Any Marine or Sailor within our MAG being arrested by HPD or held in custody by PMO.
- A call from a General or Flag Officer.
- Any incidents of Officer or SNCO misconduct.
- Any incident that requires an OPREP-3/SIR notification involving MAG-24 personnel.
- Any aircraft incident that can embarrass our MAG or the base.
- Any media encounters—be sensitive to those events that have media potential.
- Any event that can bring discredit or embarrassment to the Marine Corps.
