

<u>Commanding Officer's Policy Statement on</u> <u>Sexual Assault Prevention and Response</u>



Sexual assault is a criminal act that erodes unit cohesion, contradicts Marine Corps core values, and will not be tolerated. Maintaining a safe, healthy environment is critical to operational readiness, and essential to supporting the well-being of our Marines, Sailors and their families. Our Sexual Assault and Prevention Response Victim Advocates (SAPR-VA) and Sexual Assault Response Coordinators (SARC) are key resources, and are available to assist.

<u>Responsibilities of All Marines</u>

All Marines will be familiar with MCO 1752.5C, and **immediately report all incidents of sexual assault** that come under observation (e.g., witness sexual assault).

- Treat each other with dignity and respect.
- Be an active bystander by intervening if possible and notifying law enforcement.
- Understand the two reporting options: Restricted and Unrestricted

<u>Restricted Report</u>

A restricted report is a **confidential report** that enables the victim access to medical, informational and mental health services **without command or law enforcement** notification, and can be changed to Unrestricted at any time. Restricted Reporting options:

- SAPR-VA or SARC
- Victim's Legal Counsel (VLC)
- Healthcare providerChaplain

<u>Unrestricted Report</u>

The victim receives the same resources as with a Restricted Report, but the report carries an **official investigation.** Although not confidential, the victim's identity is **limited to those with "need to know"** (e.g. unit commander and investigators).

- Includes law enforcement and the command.
- Cannot be converted to a Restricted Report.

<u>Victims</u>

Victims of sexual assault shall be protected, treated with dignity and respect, and shall receive timely access to medical treatment and mental health services. Victims are encouraged to report without fear of retaliation, reprisal, ostracism, or maltreatment.
