HOUSING

Once you get orders, you may be wondering, "Where are we going to live?" The housing office operates differently here, and you may not know where you will be living until you get on the island. Be prepared to live in a hotel for at least 2 weeks.



MACS-4 is located on MCAS Futenma. If you are living on base, your options could be Camp Kinser, Camp Lester, and Camp Foster. MCAS Futenma does not have family housing on base.

Port to Home Program

- This is a recent development where you can work with your sponsor to sign for an on-base house before you arrive. You may move in as soon as you get on the island.
- If you have pets and plan to live on base, we highly suggest looking into this option.

CAR/LICENSE

How do I get a car so I can go explore this wonderful little island?!

After you attend the New Join Brief, you'll take the test for your SOFA driver's license. Make sure to study all the road signs because you will have to match them. The test also contains multiple-choice questions.

Used cars are extremely cheap here compared to the states. You can either buy a car from someone who is selling theirs, or you can go through a dealership. The dealerships tend to be a bit more expensive, but you get a warranty and other perks. You should expect to pay roughly \$1000-\$6000 for a vehicle. Additionally, road tax must be paid every year, and JCI inspection is conducted every 2 years. Vehicle registration and insurance paperwork can be completed on base.

How do I call back home or call locally in Japan?

There are different options and opinions:

- If you want to keep your stateside phone number, use T-Mobile or Google Fi.
- You can also get a Japanese phone and number through AU or SoftBank (both are located on base).
- Another option is having both an American number and a Japanese number through a virtual SIM card.
- Making calls on Wi-Fi through FaceTime, WhatsApp, and other apps is another great way to cut down on cost.



Where do I go for medical and dental care? Can I go off base?

Healthcare is provided through the Naval Hospital Okinawa that is located on Camp Foster with branch clinics on Futenma and Kinser. Sign up for TRICARE Online to make appointments, see your health record, and use secure messaging to talk with your provider. https://www.tricareonline.com/

There is Urgent Care at the Naval Hospital on SATURDAYS ONLY. They are open 10am to 6pm by appointment only by calling DSN 646-7311 or 098-971-7311. If you or a family member needs medical attention for emergencies or outside of a scheduled appointment time, proceed directly to the ER.



Dental care is provided on base, but you also have the option to go off base. Okinawa White Dental and Sakura Dental Care are two places out in town that take Tricare. Both of these places out in town have friendly staff who are great with kids. Sometimes, Saturday appointments are available as well.





What's the process for bringing our furry ones with us?
