Policy on Substance Abuse

"Alcohol abuse and the distribution, possession, use, trafficking or distribution of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia is contrary to the effective performance of Marines and to the Marine Corps mission, and will not be tolerated. Alcohol and drug offences must and will be dealt with swiftly and effectively." -MCO 5300.17

Alcohol and drug abuse impede our decision making skills, rot unit cohesion, destroy families, and ruin careers. Don't put yourself in this position, if you need help seek it out. There are resources available to help you. When one Marine or Sailor is in trouble, the whole team suffers.

Leaders at every level are charged with setting the example and with mentoring their Marines on the dangers and consequences of substance abuse. Educate your Marines and provide assistance when required. Protect what you have worked so hard to achieve.

If you are underage and choose to consume alcohol or if you are of age and contribute alcohol to underage Marines, be prepared to face the consequences. Likewise, any use of illegal drugs/substances will not be tolerated. Marines, you will be held accountable for your actions. Ensure that you do the right thing.
