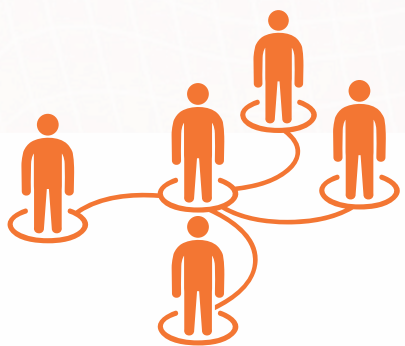
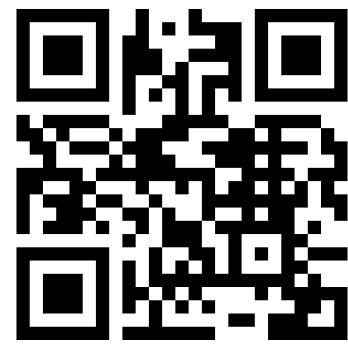

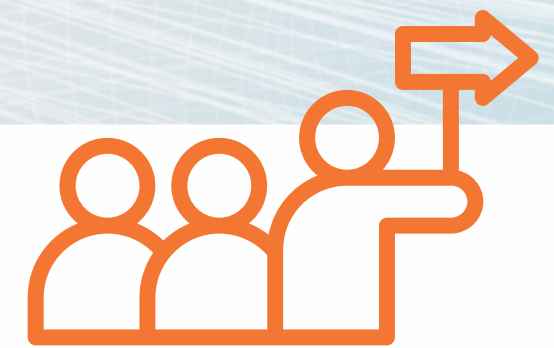
Civilian Leader Development Program

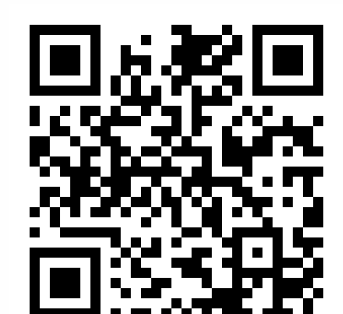
