
#### SEXUAL ASSAULT BREAKS OUR OATH.

My command philosophy is Always Faithful – To Our Nation, Our Corps, and Ourselves.

## Always Faithful to Our Nation:

We uphold the Constitution by obeying the law and supporting the rights of others. Sexual assault is a violation of both the law and the rights of others and will not be tolerated – those who commit sexual assault will be held accountable!



## Always Faithful to Our Corps:

- Sexual assault is not in line with our core values.
- MAG-36 commands will educate and create a climate that prevents sexual assault.
- Commands will ensure neither the victim nor the accused are ostracized during an investigation.
- We have a duty to each other.
  - Sexual assault is often associated with alcohol consumption be alert.
  - Step up and prevent sexual assault before it occurs.
  - o Provide support and know where to find appropriate care.

#### Always Faithful to Ourselves:

- If you are a victim of sexual assault, you need to know it is NOT YOUR FAULT.
- Victims are encouraged to do an **unrestricted** report.
- Those who choose **restricted** reporting in accordance with 1752.5C will have their choice honored and will not be re-victimized.

Leaders will ensure every member knows who and how to contact their SAPR Victim Advocates (VA). Apply the philosophy of *Always Faithful* and uphold your Oath so that together we can eliminate sexual assault from our ranks.
