## Sexual Assault Prevention and Response



Sexual assault is a **criminal act**. MCO 1752.5C Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) defines sexual assault as "intentional sexual contact, characterized by the use of force, threats, intimidation, or abuse of authority or when the victim does not or cannot consent." Sexual assault is one of the most destructive acts that can ever be perpetrated on an individual and it tears at the very fabric of a unit. Any unrestricted reports of sexual assault committed by individuals assigned to VMM-363 will be thoroughly investigated and perpetrators will be held accountable.

**Sexual Assault directly contradicts our core values and erodes our unity – and will not be tolerated!** Military members who observe the crime or act in a law enforcement capacity, are mandatory reporters and therefore must report known, suspected, or alleged sexual assaults to the victim's chain of command. Victims of sexual assault will be treated with dignity, respect, discretion and provided all appropriate care available. We will strengthen our bonds by actively supporting and safeguarding our teammates and family members, ensuring **no one is left vulnerable.**

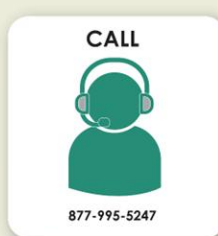
